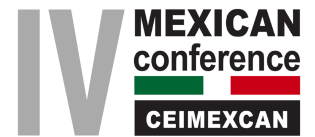

Participation format

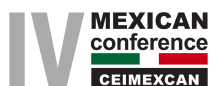
- Oral presentation: A 20-minute presentation with 5 minutes for questions.
- Poster exhibition: You are welcome to bring a new poster or one from a recent conference.

Note: English is preferred for the international distribution of the papers/posters/presentations.

Eligibility for presentations and posters

1. Graduate students or researchers in Canada who were born in Mexico or whose parents are of Mexican origin. All fields of work are acceptable.
2. Graduate students or researchers of other nationalities currently working in a Canadian institution on a topic related to Mexico.

The organizers encourage the participation of all those interested. All the proposals are welcome and will be included in the programme. In case that special observations or recommendations are needed to improve the quality of the work, they will be sent to the applicants as soon as possible after submission.



Costs

Attendance to the conference is open to the general public and there is no registration fee. Transportation, accommodation and meals should be covered by the participants.

Please note that:

- As in previous years, the organizing committee will do its best to find affordable accommodation for participants with the members of the Mexican community in the area. Please let us know if you want us to help you to find this kind of accommodation in Ottawa-Gatineau.
- All Canadian universities and other funding institutions offer travel grants for presentations at conferences during the year. We will be happy to provide you with participation letters to support your application or request for funding. The letters will be signed by the authorities of CEIMEXCAN and UNAM-ESECA.

Submission process - Important dates

First call:

The deadline for abstracts is July 30, 2009

We encourage you to send by email the title, author(s) name(s) and a 250-word abstract. The aim of this exercise is to allow the committee to define the different areas to be covered and to help the authors apply for travel grants and request assistance with accommodations.

Second -and final- call

The deadline to submit your work is September 1, 2009

Please send by email your personal information and a full manuscript of your work. This document must be between 2 and 8 pages and should be sent in a single WORD, LATEX or PDF file named as follows: "YourName–ContributionTitle.doc" (.tex or .pdf). Manuscripts should be written in English.

1. Personal information required:
 - Title of the contribution
 - Field of work (specialty)
 - Author(s)
 - Institution(s)
 - Address and email of main author
 - Desired participation format
2. Manuscript Format:
 - Title of contribution
 - Abstract (maximum 250 words)
 - Manuscript (12pt font, single spacing, maximum 8 pages including abstract, figures and references)

Proceedings and material

A diploma will be awarded to all participants.

Papers/projects (with permission from the authors), images of the conference and some notes from conference discussions will be uploaded to the conference's webpage, which plays an essential role in promoting the work among different institutions and companies.

We also intend to prepare a CD with conference proceedings (including manuscripts) to be handed out on the day of the event, but this will be subject to the availability of funds.
